We recently became aware of the proposed legislation on EGCS and sewage and greywater discharge. Unfortunately, the document is only available in Finnish. We managed to translated a few sections.

We have a few concerns:

- 1. The term "untreated wash water used in exhaust gas cleaning systems" is mentioned, but it's unclear what "treated" means or which parameters are used. Does this refer to a specific MEPC resolution?
- 2. For treated sewage discharge, does this apply to ships with approved treatments in compliance with MEPC Resolution 275(69)?
- 3. Regarding treated grey water, which parameters or treatments is Finland referring to?

We would appreciate it if those comments were included in the discussion.
