Headquartered in San Francisco, the C4IR Network was created as a new space for global cooperation dedicated to developing governance protocols and frameworks that accelerate the application of science and technology in the global public interest. Today the network spans 13 jurisdictions that are managed and operated locally by trusted partners.

Opportunity to join the C4IR Network

Within the framework of the new collaboration, Finland has a unique opportunity to establish an Affiliate Centre to join the Centre for the Fourth Industrial Revolution (C4IR) Network. The Finnish affiliate would have a special focus on questions relating to data policy and data economy.

Launching an Affiliate Centre in Finland focused on developing and piloting governance protocols for the Fourth Industrial Revolution offers an opportunity to Finland to become an international Centre of Excellence in the Data Economy leveraging the country's existing strengths in this field with the C4IR Network's innovative approaches to technology governance.

The network gives an unmatched possibility to **influence and participate** in the development of new regulatory frameworks to enhance the use of technology across sectors, the **adoption of new technologies** and the evolution of an enabling regulatory environment as well as **support business and corporate cooperation**. It caters for **knowledge sharing and discourse** with other global stakeholders working at the cutting edge of technology development and implementation. The network would give Finland and those involved unparalleled **global visibility** as a technological pioneers committed to **implementing innovation** and systemic change in building the new digital future.

Now, our quest at the national level is to explore whether establishing a Finnish Affiliate Centre would be a desirable objective. We must determine whether it would be possible to attract a large enough group of operators that would be keen on taking this initiative further, and formulate a concept that would bring added value in the context of the World Economic Forum and the C4IR Network.

Call to action to join the collaboration group

The purpose is to bring together all interested parties, from small to big IT companies, to plan the concept, content and organisation of the Finnish C4IR Network Affiliate Centre's activities.

We are now calling on all actors interested in making an impact through active participation to come forward and join the collaboration group. Based on the work initiated in the collaboration group, the decision to open a Finnish C4IR Network Affiliate Centre will be made in the spring of 2021.

The collaboration group will

- formulate the concept and network for the Finnish C4IR ecosystem
- plan the operating model and organisation of the Finnish affiliate
- outline the strategy and operational work programme of the Finnish affiliate
- integrate the affiliate's activities into other related work at the national, EU and international levels
- contribute to the financing and management of the site.
