



share and test tools and approaches to a specific health







The TEHDAS Joint Action helps the Members States and the Commission by developing and promoting concepts for sharing of data in secondary use

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Preliminary study on funding sources fand costs of secondary use of health data in the EU

- Overview of the EU's funding instruments
 - Calls specifically addressing the secondary use of health data are scheduled in the second half of 2022. Two direct grants to MS authorities on the EHDS infrastructure and governance:

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- primary use of data (€30 mill.)
- secondary use of data (€30 mill.)
- National resources and financing
 - Examples from Findata (3 mill €/year), Denmark , and the Netherlands (110 mill €)
- Financing of current EU data sharing mechanisms
 - Examples from on agency- and project-based funding
 - ECDC/TESSy; MyHealth@EU; ERNs/CPMS; Elixir; DARWIN; PHIRI
