Government Registry Automation Project

The Prime Minister's Office has launched the Government Registry Automation Project, which will automate the activities of the Government Registry. The project will be carried out from 18 January 2021 until 31 December 2022. Preparations for the automation project began in September 2020.

The goal of the project is to automate the manual routine operations involved in the Registry's activities using software robotics and artificial intelligence applications.

The Government and its ministries will also utilise the solutions, platforms, licences, experiences and expertise acquired by the Prime Minister's Office through the project for tasks outside of registry automation.

The project is being implemented based on preliminary studies and discussions in cooperation with the Government Shared Services Centre for Finance and Human Resources Management using the centre's existing solutions and expertise in a variety of areas, including software robotics. With regard to artificial intelligence, the project will continue to work with the Government ICT Centre Valtori.

The senior management group of the Information Management and ICT Division at the Prime Minister's Office will act as the project steering committee. The project's activities follow the project model and guidelines of the Prime Minister's Office.

The project costs consist of expert services, platform services, equipment and licences purchased from an external supplier and its subcontractors or other service providers. Officials at the Prime Minister's Office will participate in the project as part of their duties. The project has received EUR 237,000 in funding from the Ministry of Finance's Robohaku 2020 robotics funding programme.
