	Finding (FD-3)
	There was no evidence of a methodology for carrying out periodic inspections of the ships flying the flag of the State to verify that the actual condition of the ship and her crew were in conformity with the certificates she carried, and that the requirements of the mandatory IMO instruments were met. (III Code, paragraph 22.2.)
	Finding (FD-4)
	The Administration did not have a documented system for qualification and continuous updating of the knowledge for the personnel assisting in the performance of the work of surveyors/inspectors. (III Code, paragraph 33; III Code, paragraph 35).
Coastal State activities	Finding (FD-5)
	The maritime administration did not review the existing traffic separation scheme since its inception, in accordance with the guidelines and criteria stipulated in SOLAS regulation V/10.8. (SOLAS 1974, regulation V/10; III Code, paragraph 49).
Port State activities	None.
